Our 12-bed hospice residence provides individual private rooms with private baths; common living areas such as the Tea Room and Music Room; chapel; spa; and covered porch; and family areas including a full-size kitchen and dining room and two family suites for out of town family visitors.



Situated on Turkey Hill in Hingham, Massachusetts, we are surrounded by a lush lawn and gardens, as well as beautiful vistas featuring neighboring Weir River Farm Reservation and Hingham Harbor as a backdrop for the majestic Boston skyline.

Who Comes to Live at a Hospice House?

- 🌿 Anyone qualified to receive hospice services who cannot remain within their own home for end-of-life care.
- 🌿 Patients already living on the South Shore, or who wish to move closer to family on the South Shore.
- 🌿 Patients under hospice care who can no longer be cared for at home such as an elderly person whose spouse is unable to provide such care; a person living alone without family nearby; younger patients who don't want their young children to experience death in the family home.

What Services are Provided?

In addition to all the services one would receive from hospice when living in one's own home, hospice residence patients receive:

- 🌿 Round the clock nursing care as needed from licensed practical nurses, under the supervision of a registered nurse
- 🌿 Assistance with personal care from home health aides, also available round the clock.
- 🌿 Visits from the hospice team including the registered nurse, social worker, physician, chaplain, bereavement counselor, and volunteers (as desired).
- 🌿 Breakfast, lunch and dinner
- 🌿 Housekeeping and laundry service

How is Residential Care Paid?

- 🌿 Room and board fees are paid by the patient and/or family at a reasonable rate.
- 🌿 Medicare and Medicaid do not cover residence room and board. However, some private insurers and long term care providers may.
- 🌿 Medical insurers such as Medicare, Medicaid and managed care plans do cover the cost of the hospice care, medications and medical equipment provided at the hospice residence, just as it would be covered in one's own home.

How are Patients Referred?

 A doctor or healthcare provider can refer patients to the Hospice Residence by contacting **NVNA and Hospice** at **781.783.1627**.

 Patients are screened by the Hospice Residence staff. Upon move-in, a care plan by the Hospice Residence team is put into place.

 Medicare continues to pay for the hospice services while the patient and/or family pays for the residence room and board.
